Request received:

My name is Brian Kramer. I live in Sidney Ohio and have been a part of the Emmaus and Chrysalis community here. I have a friend who has a rare heart condition which can only be treated in two places in the U.S. One is Cleveland Oh, and the other is at the University of California San Diego. His doctors are recommending the California facility. He is on Medicaid and the medical procedure will be covered, but he, his wife and young son need a place to stay. Depending on his testing and if he qualifies for the surgery, he may require to be in California for up to a month. The plan is for him to be in California on July 7th. I am prayerfully reaching out and trying to find help for housing for him and his family.
